Job Summary

This is a full-time, non-exempt position that reports to the Director of Gardens. Responsible for performing activities related to the care and maintenance of the gardens, landscape and grounds. Pay range is \$16 - \$18/hour.

Essential Functions

- Perform all needed horticultural activities, including planting, pruning, fertilizing, watering, weeding, mulching, and pesticide applications, pest control, garden cleanup, custodial tasks and any other activities directed by supervisors.
- Operate and maintain hand tools, power tools (chain saw, blower, lawnmower, and string trimmer), electric carts, tractors and other equipment.
- Assist with the maintenance and installation of irrigation systems.
- Assist with the care and maintenance of plants in the Garden nursery.
- Assist in the setup and take down of tables, chairs, and other equipment for classes, workshops, meetings and events, as needed.
- Assist with other SDBG activities and tasks as needed.

Competencies

- Have a general knowledge of plants and their culture.
- Work well with other staff and volunteers as a team player.
- Customer service oriented, interact with visitors in a courteous and helpful manner.

Preferred

- College-level course work in horticulture and allied fields is preferred
- Experience in grounds and garden maintenance, nursery work, or landscaping.
- Experience with administrative duties or overseeing others.

Work Scheduling

- Must be available to work some holiday, weekend and evening shifts.
- Must be able to work outdoors in all types of weather including rainy days.

Physical Requirements

- Able to work a full shift outdoors with strenuous activity
- Able to lift and carry a minimum of 50 lbs. a distance of 25 feet frequently
